Students will learn to defend what they believe through discussing apologetic's topics, preparing to give speeches, and giving and listening to speeches which answer questions about what they believe. The 105 questions used in NCFCA tournaments are the questions used for this course. Pastor Chap Bettis' book and videos are the primary materials used, besides the Bible. Each class, students will come prepared to give 1-3 speeches, each up to six minutes in length, although at most one will be given. Although not the main goal of the class, due to the extent of preparation, the class could be counted as English credit for high school. Students will use, and thus improve, in their note taking, outlining, researching, writing essays, and public speaking skills as well as active listening and peer editing skills.
